FREQUENCY OF NARCISSISTIC PERSONALITY DISORDER IN ...

The narcissist can often be drawn into the practice of seeking "spiritual perfectionism and validating shame-based scrupulosity and self-punishment" (ampbell & Miller 2011, 414) This is a self-defeating Möbius cycle having only one side and one boundary that never ends, for its goals are impossible to reach and the means are self-defeating
